What Can You Send?

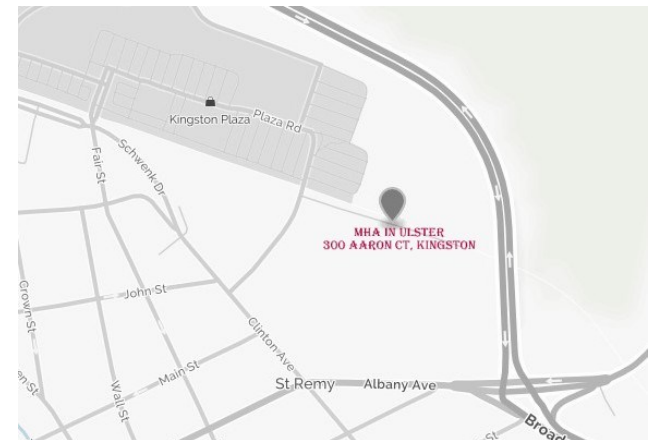
- **Something to wear.** . socks, T-shirts, winter hats, scarves, sweaters, gloves, and sweatshirts.
